

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AJAX

BY-LAW NUMBER 60-98

Being a By-law Prohibiting Noises.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Ajax enacts as follows:

1. DEFINITIONS:

"Construction" includes any excavating, construction, demolition, alteration, repair to any property, including buildings, and shall include the delivery or movement of any equipment or materials intended for use in construction.

"Construction Noise" means sound originating from construction on premises and received on other premises.

- 2.1 No person shall ring any bell, blow or sound any horn or cause the same to be rung, blown or sounded, shout, or create, cause or permit any unusual noise, or noises likely to disturb the inhabitants of the Town of Ajax.
- 2.2 For the purposes of this by-law, Construction Noise shall be deemed to be unusual or likely to disturb the inhabitants if created on Statutory Holidays or between the hours of 8:00pm one day to 7:00am on the following day, Monday to Friday, and 5:00pm on Friday to 9:00am on Saturday, and 5:00pm on Saturday to 7:00am on Monday.
3. The provisions of this by-law shall not apply to:
- a) the emission of noises in connection with emergency services;
 - b) the emission of noise, in a reasonable manner, by the use of any apparatus or mechanism for the amplification of sound in connection with a public or festive activity approved or permitted by the Town of Ajax;
 - c) any activity approved by Resolution of Council.
4. If a Court of competent jurisdiction should declare any section or part of a section of this by-law to be invalid, such section or part of a section shall not be construed as having persuaded or influenced Council to pass the remainder of this by-law and it is hereby declared that the remainder of the by-law shall be valid and shall remain in force.
5. Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine or penalty for each offence, exclusive of costs, as prescribed by the *Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990 c. P.33*, as amended.

6. By-law #35-98 is hereby repealed.
